

Directive No. 01/2024 Regarding the Establishment of Document Templates, the Logo, and the Website of the Organisation

Guardians of Polish & Christian Heritage

Dated 5th March 2024

Pursuant to the Founding Act dated 15th January 2024 and subsequent acts of the Organisation **GUARDIANS OF POLISH & CHRISTIAN HERITAGE (15417549)**, as the Owner-Director General and a Member of the Organisation, I hereby decree:

§ 1

1. To establish the use of Membership Cards by all Members of the Organisation.
2. To establish the use of a Supporter Card, hereinafter referred to as the Morality Guardian Card, by all Supporters and those backing the Organisation.

- Membership Cards will contain:

- a) Obverse: The Organisation's Logo along with the Organisation's name, First Name, Last Name, Date of document issue, Gender, Date of birth, Membership Number (consistent with the membership number), role and function in the Organisation, passport photo. In the bottom left corner, there is a flag (in the form of a shield) of the country from which the Member of the Organisation originates.
- b) Reverse: Organisation's details, Validity date, Space for a hologram with the Organisation's logo, QR code leading to the official website of the Organisation.

Membership Cards are printed on PVC plates in metallic blue, dimensions: 86mm x 54mm. Due to the registration of the Organisation's activities in the United Kingdom, cards are issued in English, including Polish characters only with respect to the first and last name (record-keeping for cards in Poland, due to the conditions in the United Kingdom, will be conducted without Polish diacritical marks).

- Morality Guardian Cards will include:

- a) Obverse: The Organisation's Logo along with the Organisation's name, First Name, Last Name, Date of issue, Gender, Date of birth, Supporter Number, passport photo. In the bottom left corner, there is a flag (in the form of a shield) of the country from which the Supporter originates.
- b) Reverse: Organisation's details, Validity date, Space for a hologram with the Organisation's logo, QR code leading to the official website of the Organisation. Morality Guardian Cards are printed on PVC plates in gold metal colour, dimensions: 86mm x 54mm. Due to the registration of the Organisation's activities in the United Kingdom, cards are issued in English, including Polish characters only with respect to the first and last name (record-keeping for cards in Poland, due to the conditions in the United Kingdom, will be conducted without Polish diacritical marks).

Morality Guardian Cards are printed on PVC plates in gold metal colour, dimensions: 86mm x 54mm. Due to the registration of the Organisation's activities in the United Kingdom, cards are issued in English, including Polish characters only with respect to

the first and last name (record-keeping for cards in Poland, due to the conditions in the United Kingdom, will be conducted without Polish diacritical marks). Morality Guardian Cards do not equate to obtaining membership in the Organisation. The acquisition of membership and a Member's Card is conducted in the manner described in the Organisation's Statute.

§ 2

1. To establish the official logo of the Organisation, which features a centrally placed coat of arms with a white eagle in a crown on a red background. It is surrounded by military elements: crossed swords, cannons, as well as laurel leaves and stars. At the top of the emblem, there is a crown. The entire composition is symmetrical and rich in detail, executed in dark and metallic shades with white and gold accents on a red background.
2. The logo will be used in all documents, publications, and promotional materials of the Organisation.
3. The Organisation confirms that the logo is its exclusive intellectual property and reserves the right to its use. No person or entity is authorised to use this logo without the explicit written consent of the Organisation.
