## **POWER OF ATTORNEY**

### **to Act on Behalf of the Organisation in Legal Matters**

### **§1. Grant of Authority**

I, the undersigned, acting as **Executive Director** of the Organisation Guardians of Polish & Christian Heritage, hereby grant this Power of Attorney to:

**Victor Vexley**, a national of the United Kingdom,

to act in the name of and on behalf of the Organisation.

### **§2. Position**

The Attorney-in-Fact holds the position of:

**Head of Legal Office**

and acts within the Legal Office of the Organisation.

---

### **§3. Scope of Authority**

The Attorney-in-Fact is authorised to act on behalf of the Organisation in all legal matters, including in particular:

1. Drafting, reviewing and signing legal documents.
  2. Representing the Organisation before individuals, legal entities, institutions and public authorities.
  3. Submitting applications, notifications, complaints and other formal documents.
  4. Conducting legal and official correspondence.
  5. Undertaking legal and factual actions necessary to protect the interests of the Organisation.
  6. Acting on behalf of the Organisation in proceedings before institutions and administrative authorities.
  7. Taking all actions necessary for the proper functioning of the Legal Office.

## §4. Extent of Authority

The Attorney-in-Fact is authorised to act independently, in the name of the Organisation and under the authority of the Board of Directors.

This Power of Attorney constitutes a broad authorisation covering all legal and factual actions relating to the Organisation's legal matters, except for those reserved exclusively to the Board of Directors.

The Attorney-in-Fact is also authorised to sign documents on behalf of the Organisation in accordance with the established rules of representation.

## §5. Duration

This Power of Attorney is granted for an indefinite period.

It may be revoked at any time by the Executive Director or the Board of Directors.

## §6. Responsibility

The Attorney-in-Fact acts on behalf of the Organisation; however, ultimate responsibility for the Organisation remains with the Board of Directors, in accordance with applicable UK law, including the Companies Act 2006.

---

## §7. Entry into Force

This Power of Attorney shall enter into force on the date of signing.
